On the 12 clubs each National Governing Body has proposed in September 2015, only 9 of them gave us a positive answer: **Rethel Ardennes (FR)**, **Wolves Charleroi (BE)**, **HC RUBI CENT PATINS (ES)**, **HC Laupersdorf (SWI)**, **ihcSF Linth (SWI)**, **HC Milano Quanta (IT)**, **Les Tigres de Garges (FR)**, **Norton Cyclones (UK)**, **Bruxelles Phenix (BE)**. **ISC Mannheim (DE)** joined the event. We thought the registration was over.

CERILH received a request from the Spanish Federation, asking us to approve the replacement of Espanya by **CPL Valladolid (ES)**. CERILH committee approved it and after trying to find a 12th club, in order to organize a tournament with an even number of teams, that we didn't find, CERILH finally closed the registration with 11 ones.

CERILH is so delighted and proud that European Clubs Competition can restart. I really think that CERILH is now in a good way. Rules have been made in order to treat this main expectation of roster not reinforced only for the event. Be sure that all CERILH members and National Governing Bodies will be concentrated on this subject.

Arrival date and official training: Wednesday 2nd or Thursday 3rd depending on teams registration and planning

Championship: From Thursday 3rd to Sunday 6th

3. CATEGORIES & AGES

Based on CERILH CLUBS Competition regulations, article 6.3 and 6.4, the competition is opened to senior men teams

Senior: Minimum age of fifteen (15) years of age

In March 2016, senior are players born before 3rd march 2001

9. FORMAT FOR THE COMPETITION

Based on the European League Regulations (please refer to the European League Regulation, art 4. for more information):

Overall Tournament (art 4.1 to 4.18 for more info)

The 2016 CERILH European League is played in a format based of:

- A round robin with two groups depending on the number of teams registering
- A final phase consisting in semi-finals and finals for two different levels that are the European League Trophy and Cup of the President Trophy

Match system (art 4.19 to 4.21 for more info)

- ✦ (2x20) minutes with a half-time break according to the FIRS Rules of the Game
- ✦ Five (5) minutes over time in case of a draw (sudden death system)
- ✦ A three (3) shoots on goal session in case of a draw after sudden death
- ✦ A one (1) shoot on goal repeated session until one team defeat its opponent

Attribution of points (art 4.23 to 4.25 for more info)

- ✦ Three (3) points for a regular win
- ✦ One (1) point for a loss **and two (2) points for a win** after a draw in regular time
- ✦ No point for a loss in regular time

Group classification (art 4.27 to 4.29 for more info)

By adding up the number of points won by each team in each group match

Case of equality of points:

- ✦ Points obtained in the group matches played among the teams in question
- ✦ Lowest total number of goals-allowed from the group matches played
- ✦ Lowest total number of goals-allowed from the group matches played among the teams in question
- ✦ The highest total of goals scored from the group matches played among the teams in question
